

AWARD AMOUNTS

10 to 15 Awards - up to \$5,000/award

PURPOSE

To provide research opportunities for students interested in a career in biomedical science.

Description & Eligibility (see attached agreement)

- i. These awards are designated for undergraduate students or medical students interested in working under the supervision of a CBR Postdoctoral Fellow for 3 - 4 months over the summer period. The student must be directly supervised by the Applicant with the approval of the Applicant's PI.
- ii. Only 1 award may be held per CBR Postdoctoral Fellow.
- iii. There are no restrictions in terms of biomedical discipline, other than the project should be aligned with the mission of the CBR.
- iv. Students must do an oral and a poster presentation of their work or work-in-progress at the CBR Research Day to be held in the Life Sciences Centre in August, date TBD.
- v. Students must participate in all CBR-organized summer events (see attached agreement to be signed by student).
- vi. The student CANNOT simultaneously hold any other award. However, a "top-up" to bring the payment to an equivalent level of other students may be provided at the discretion of the CBR PI supervisor.
- vii. **Before Sept 1**, the student must provide a 1-page report that includes a statement of the goal of the project, methods and accomplishments, and finally an assessment of the overall program and the value of the experience. This should be sent to julie.kora@ubc.ca.
- viii. The CBR should be acknowledged in publications and presentations of work arising out of this award.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Complete applications with signed Award Conditions by the student must be submitted to julie.kora@ubc.ca before **April 1**.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. On a single letter-size page, with font equivalent to or greater than Times 11, the Postdoctoral Fellow should provide a brief description of the project, how the student will participate, and what s/he is likely to accomplish in terms of knowledge and skills.
- ii. The student's CV (2 page limit) that includes all contact information should be attached.
- iii. The student, postdoctoral fellow and PI must sign the agreement to participate in CBR summer events, or jeopardize the receipt of the award.

CBR Summer Studentship Award Conditions

The CBR Summer Studentship Program is a terrific opportunity to get hands-on experience in the lab and/or the clinic, to be exposed to a wide range of biomedical disciplines and technologies, and to gain insights into career options. It is also a chance to meet people with varied backgrounds and experiences, at all levels of training.

This award is highly competitive. Those who accept the award are expected to participate in all aspects of the program.

To accept the award, you must agree to the following:

- i. I am an undergraduate university student. I do not hold any other award to support me during the tenure of the CBR summer studentship award.
- ii. I will work under the supervision of a CBR Postdoctoral Fellow (PDF) and a Principle Investigator (PI) over the summer period. The PI may choose to give me a "top-up" at his/her discretion.
- iii. I will present my research work-in-progress as a poster and in a 3-minute oral presentation (details to follow) at the CBR Research Day symposium at UBC.
- iv. I will participate in **all** CBR-organized summer events and my PI will ensure that time is available to attend or complete the following (details to follow):
 - 2-3 "pizza or pot-luck" social lunches with the CBR at the Life Sciences Centre.
 - 3 Tours of specialty facilities (e.g. Canadian Blood Services, NetCAD, Comparative Animal Facility).
 - 3 Research Skills sessions
 - I will provide a **final 1-page report** that includes a statement of the goal of the project, the methods and accomplishments, and finally an assessment of the overall program and the value of the experience. I will send this to julie.kora@ubc.ca.
- v. If I am unable to attend any event, I will let the CBR Education Coordinator (Julie Kora) know as soon as possible at julie.kora@ubc.ca.

I understand that failure to adhere to this agreement will jeopardize payment of the award.
