### **“Bloodsport: Finding The Thrill(s) In Science.”**

For many people, the realms of science, engineering, and research, are little more than confounding equations on a blackboard or unidentifiable specimens in a test tube. Yet even the most profound novice is awed when exposed to the unique wonders of science—especially those things that pique their imagination.

As the author of science books for both children and adults, HP Newquist's writing is designed make science attractive to those segments of the population that might not appreciate the cool factor that can be found in science. Newquist has made provocative books out of seemingly routine topics like blood, the brain, sea creatures, and autopsy reports.

Every science discipline has fascinating stories; they simply have to be exposed to light outside of the lab. In his presentation at the Centre for Blood Research, Newquist shares some of the stories he’s found during his own research, notably during the creation of “The Book Of Blood,” an award winning book about the mythology and science of blood.
