TRAVEL AWARDS

The goal of the Norman Bethune Symposium is to be an an informative and entertaining event with participation from a full range of scientists and clinicians at all levels of training.

This year's symposium will take place on **Thursday, April 18, 2024**, at UBC Robson Square in Vancouver, Canada. **Registration is free!**

The CBR believes in supporting trainees to share their research and expand their scientific horizons through travel, and to disseminate knowledge between institutions. The CBR will support travel and accommodation expenses for trainees to attend and present at the symposium. Expenses will be reimbursed to a maximum of **CAD \$1,200** after the meeting, upon submission of original receipts.

ELIGIBILITY: Trainees who are external to the CBR are eligible to apply. This includes undergraduate, MSc and PhD students, Postdoctoral Fellows and Research Associates, MDs-intraining and para-medical personnel (e.g., thrombosis-haemostasis nurses, nurse practitioners).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 2. Submit an abstract (poster or oral presentation) REQUIRED!
- **3.** Send a letter from the applicant's PI or department head that confirms the applicant's training/professional status to <u>Kaitlyn Chuong</u>
